Bachelor of Science in Business Administration

Master of Business Administration

Master of Business Administration focuses applications of management theories to practical problems in planning, organizing, finance, marketing, operations, and controlling business activity, and managerial responsibility for effective and efficient achievement.

Admission Requirements

1. Bachelor's degree, or its equivalent.
2. A minimum GPA of 2.5.
3. English Proficiency

Bachelor of Computer Science

Computer Science Program provides students elementary data structures (including arrays, stacks, queues, and lists), advanced data structures (including trees and graphs), the algorithms used to manipulate these structures, and their application to solving practical engineering problems.

Admission Requirements

1. High school diploma or its equivalent
2. All previously attended college transcripts (if applicable)
3. English Proficiency



Bachelor of Theology

This program is designed to train students for a variety of ministry opportunities in local churches and other settings. Some students enroll for personal development and to more effectively engage in a variety of volunteer ministries.

Admission Requirements

1. High school diploma or its equivalent
2. English proficiency

Master of Divinity

The M. Div. Curriculum is designed to prepare students for the pastoral leadership role in the local church & other settings. Other Christian Leaders such as Counselors or Educators may get the degree with an emphasis of each area.

Admission Requirements

1. Bachelor's degree, or its equivalent.
2. A minimum GPA of 2.5.
3. English Proficiency
